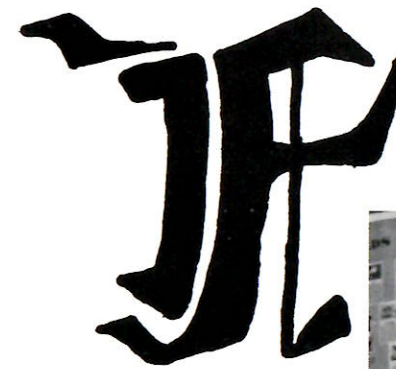
Flexible Scheduling Gains Time - - -

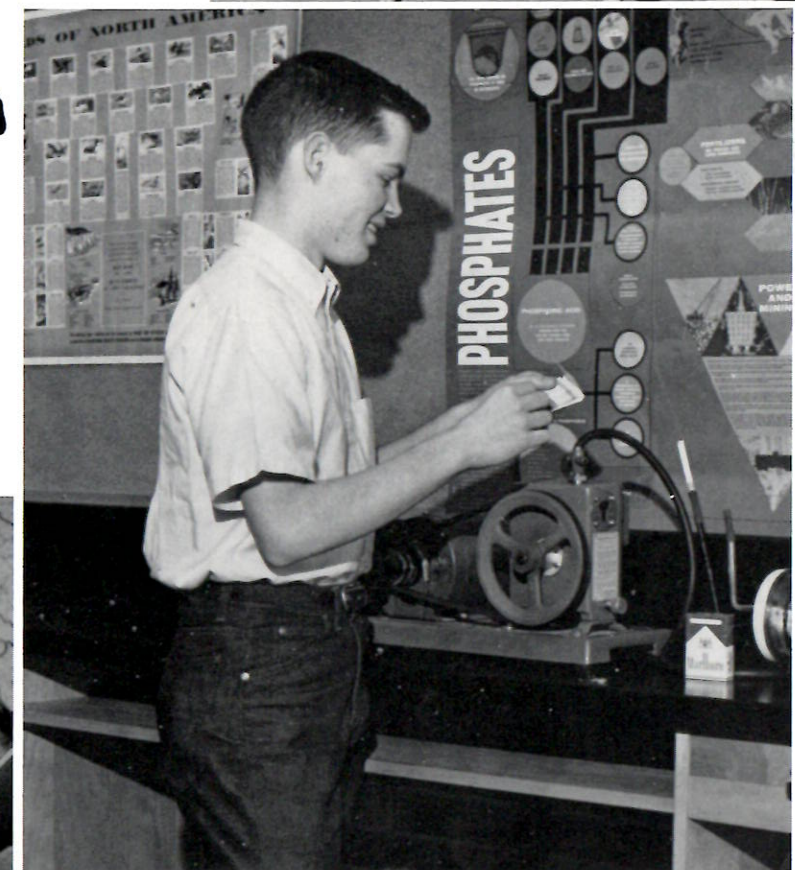
