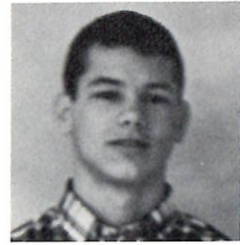

At the awards con, Lynn Gilbert was named outstanding wrestler and Bruce McDavis received the inspirational award. Pat Miller was chosen team captain.

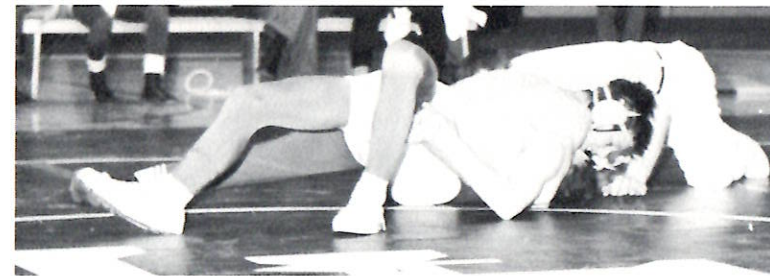
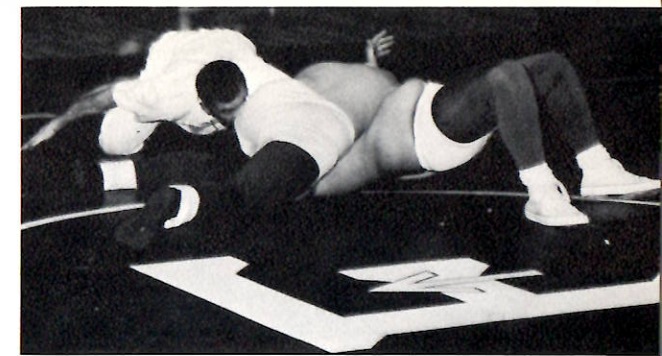
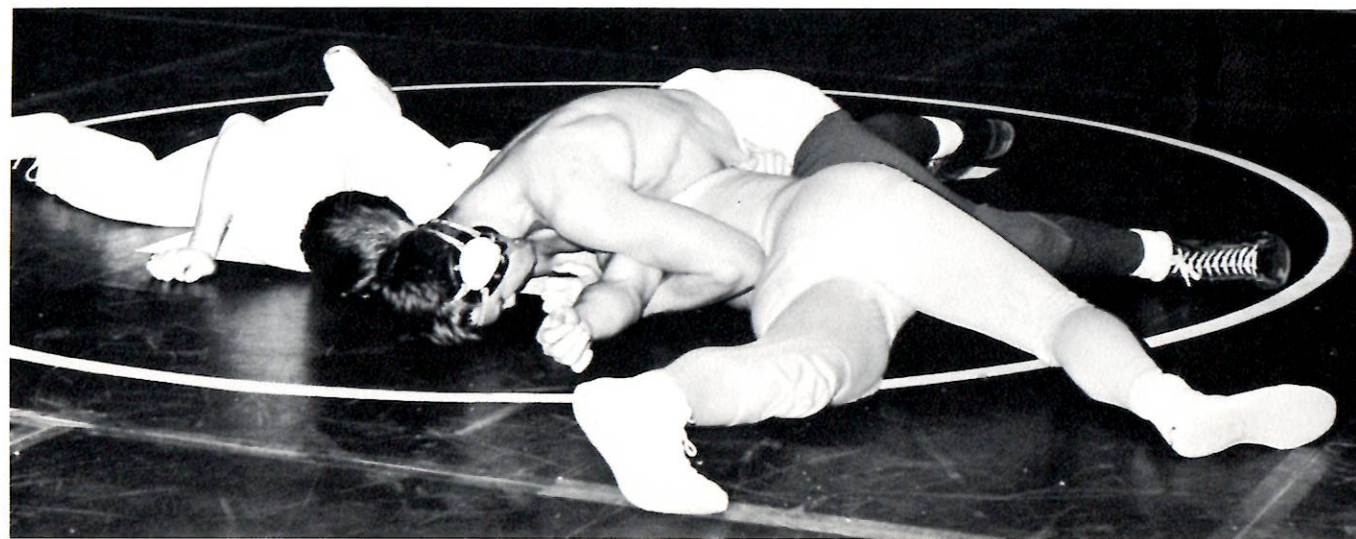

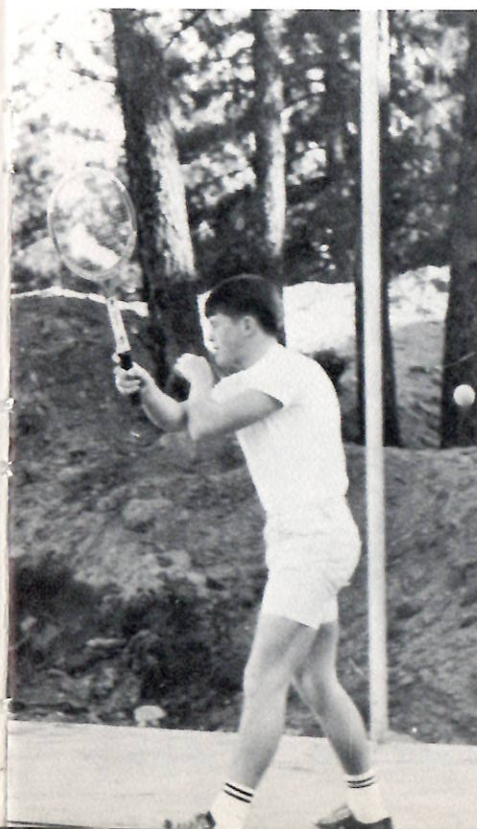
GOLF

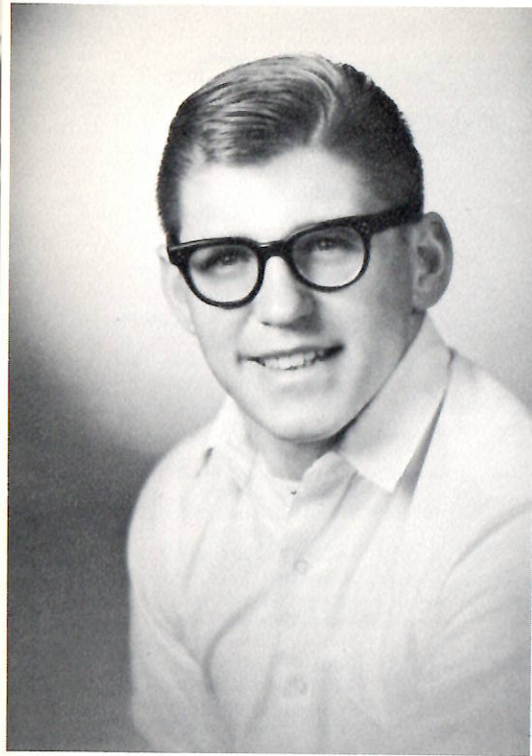

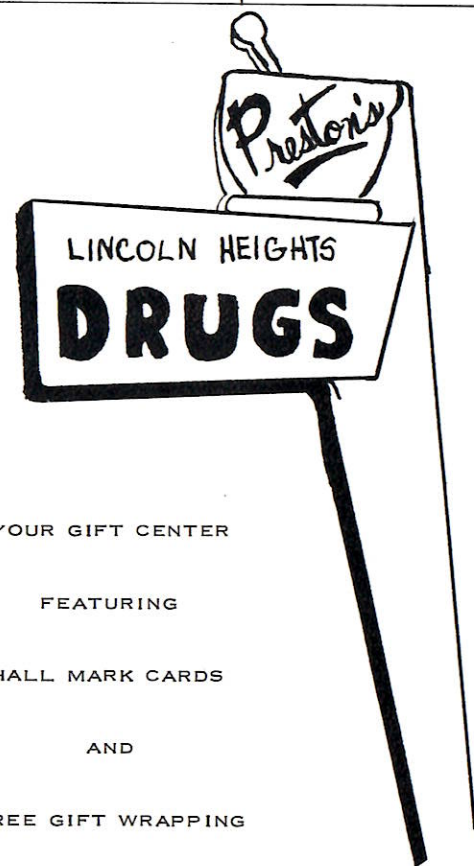
