APRIL A good time was had by all attending "County Fair," a date dance sponsored jointly by the League of Dresden and Court of Carmine, on the 30th.





Another activity of the Court of Carmine was the first joint dance with the League of Dresden. The spring dance was held on April 30 and everyone had a real swingin' time.



At the awards con, Lynn Gilbert was named outstanding wrestler and Bruce McDavis received the inspirational award. Pat Miller was chosen team captain.






Ferris' track team under the tutorage of head coach, Herm Caviness, made an excellent spring showing in the city league in 1965.






